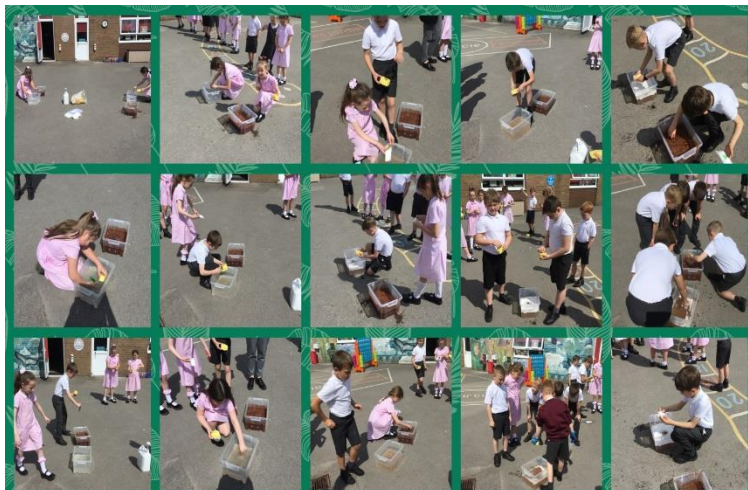
# FOCUS OF THE WEEK
