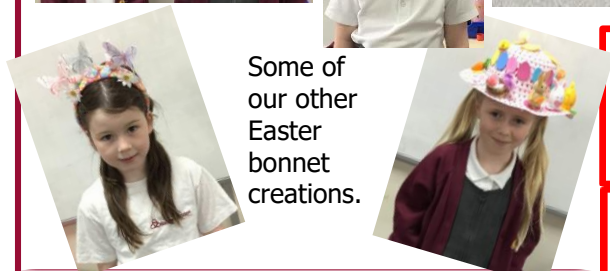


The Big Dig
