Communication and Language

Listening, attention and understanding

I can listen to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.

I can listen and attend to a dialogue in a small group of 3 or more children

I can understand a question or instruction in a familiar context that has two parts, such as "Get your coat and wait at the door".

I can understand 'who' and 'where' questions, like: "Where is the monkey?"

I can answer simple questions about myself.

I am beginning to take part in two-way conversations

Speaking

I can use a wider range of key vocabulary

I can use a larger range of verbs and nouns in short sentences and phrases.

Physical Development Gross motor skills (PE)

Dance

I can use my body to create simple shapes, movements and actions.

I can travel safely and creatively in a space.

I can remember and perform a basic sequence of movement when led by a teacher.

Stability

I can balance on one leg while standing still.

I can twist, bend and reach whilst maintaining my balance.

Number

<u>Counting</u>

I can rote count to 10

I can join in a range of number songs and rhymes to 10.

I can count up to 5 objects using 1-1 recognition and say how many.

I can get up to 4 objects from a larger group.

Match sort and compare amounts

I can match objects that are the same type.

I can sort objects into groups based on attributes e.g. shape, colour etc.

I can compare 2 quantities using language most, lots of, more, not many, fewer and the same.

Representing, comparing and composition of 1 2 3

I recognise numerals of personal significance to me.

I can begin to represent numbers to 3 in different ways using fingers, objects, pictures and marks.

Measure, shape and spatial thinking

Compare size, mass and capacity

I can use everyday language to compare 2 objects by size.

I can use language full, empty and overflowing.

I can begin to use everyday language to talk about mass in practical activities e.g. cup full, spoons, pinch of.

Shapes, pattern and positional language

I can recognise and name simple 2D shapes including circles, triangles, squares and oblongs in my environment.

I can choose appropriate 3D shapes to make models.

I can understand positional language to find out where items are. Eg: In, on, under, infront, behind, next to.

I can copy, continue and begin to create AB repeating patterns in a range of contexts using a range of materials

Time

I can use language to describe when events happen e.g. day night, morning, afternoon.

I can use story talk when playing independently and begin to use new vocabulary from a story

I am beginning to recognise and talk about how my celebrations and special people are the same and/or different to others. (CNY, Easter beliefs and traditions)
